Look what we are learning about in Term 4!

English: Students will explore a range of quality literature and participate in writing activities focusing on the theme of the Circus. For writing we will be doing Persuasive texts. Reading, writing and comprehension skills will be developed during Literacy Groups. We will also be continuing our phonics program, Sounds Write and spelling program, Spelling Mastery

Mathematics: This term we will be focusing on Chance, Measurement, Fractions and numbers. Each day we will continue to have TEN time to build our knowledge of numbers, addition and subtraction.

History : This term students will be exploring the Past in the Present. In this unit they will investigate changes in technology over time.

PE/Sport: This term students will have their weekly PE lesson on **Wednesday**. PE this term we will be learning fundamental movement skills in game based activities. Our sport day is on **Friday** and this term we are learning the basic skills of **tennis**. Students must wear sport uniform on **Wednesday and Friday**.

PD/H: Students will be investigating safe living.

Creative Arts: This term the students will be doing a unit called The Animal in Me. In this unit students will be combining a self-portrait with a drawing of an animal. We will also do weekly music lessons focusing on listening.

Science: This term we will be doing a unit called All Mixed Up in which we will explore mixtures.

Library: Mr O'Keefe will take the students every **Monday**. Students need to bring their labelled library bag and books **every Monday**.
